

## Campus Berlin-Buch / Parking Rules

1. Parking is only permitted in the designated parking spaces. The entire road network of the campus is designated as access roads for the Berlin Fire Brigade, i.e., parking is strictly prohibited even if there are no “no parking” signs. In the event of non-compliance, the vehicle will be removed at the driver’s expense. Holders of a free access permit may face the withdrawal of their permit.
2. Disabled parking spaces are available free of charge to eligible individuals. This group of people is requested to report to the gatekeeper before leaving the parking lot. It is forbidden for unauthorized persons to use these parking spaces. In the event of non-compliance, the vehicle will be removed at the driver’s expense.
3. Campus employees with a free access permit have no right to a vacant parking space. If all parking spaces are taken, they must park off-campus.
4. Campus employees have the option of renting their own reserved parking space for a monthly fee of €30.00. This fee must always be paid in advance for entire months at the ticket machines; it cannot be suspended for periods of absence. Campus employees will contact property management in advance in these cases. If a reserved parking space is used without permission, the incorrectly parked vehicle will be removed at the driver’s expense.
5. Visitors and guests can use the parking spaces free of charge for up to three hours. During this three-hour period, visitors can exit the parking lot after checking their ticket at the exit terminal. A parking fee of €1.00 per hour, or part thereof, is charged from the fourth hour onwards. Ticket machines to pay for parking tickets are located at the exits on Robert-Rössle-Straße and Lindenberger Weg.
6. After 7:00 pm, it is possible to drive onto campus and park after taking a parking ticket. Parking is then free until 06:30 am. After 06:30 am, parking fees apply.
7. On weekends and public holidays, it is possible to drive onto campus and park after taking a parking ticket. Parking is then free until 06:30 am the next working day. After 06:30 am, parking fees apply.
